This is to inform you that as per Gazette Notification of the National Council for Teachers Education issued a letter Vide - No.61-1/2011/NCTE (N\&S) dated 29.07.2011, the minimum qualification for the post of Upper Primary Teachers is Graduation and 2-years Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed).

Herein mentioned that the West Bengal Board of Primary Education also issued the Notice vide - No.465/BPE/ODL/2017 dated 30.08.2017 for admission to the 2years Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed) Course through NIOS and mentioned in the notice that "if a teacher has graduation degree with less than 50\% or 45\% (for reserved categories) in the HS or its equivalent examination, she/he not need up-gradation /improvement".

In the above context, the "NC" mentioned in the Mark Sheet of NIOS of D.El.Ed Course to the Mukhya Shiksha Samprasarak/Samprasarika In-Charge or Samprasarak/Samprasarika In-Charge or Samprasaraks/Samprasarikas of MSK for not acquiring the $50 \%$ or $45 \%$ (for reserved categories) in the HS or its equivalent examination shall be treated as successful candidates.
